Reporting to the Director, Health, Safety, Environment, and Facilities, you'll manage QEC's real estate property assets, using a portfolio-based and risk management approach that ensures value for money expended, demonstrates sound stewardship, and supports QEC service objectives, while meeting legislative and corporate requirements. As Facilities Manager, you'll be in charge of QEC's real estate property investments (125 units, \$30-million plus), including fixed and mobile assets, and both owned and leased staff housing, commercial facilities, lands, and mobile equipment/rolling stock, as well as develop policies and conduct life cycle costing to support decision-making on whether to maintain or retire assets.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Working with property owners to resolve disputes, terminate leases and negotiate new leases;
- Monitoring services provided by landlords to ensure contractual agreements are being fulfilled;
- Directing physical inspections of assets (including on-site) to ensure proper operation of building systems, weather tightness of building envelope, proper maintenance, and code compliance;
- Overseeing project implementation (contract/financial performance, conformance to schedule, and contingency planning);
- Authorizing or recommending property insurance coverage levels;
- Handling/coordinating outside and in-house consulting services of architects, engineers, etc.;
- Preparing and managing a \$9-million operations and maintenance budget for assets;
- Preparing and presenting business cases for QEC's Board and Senior Management;
- Reviewing housing leases for accuracy, payments and conditions;
- Ensuring verification of invoices for water/sewage, electrical, fuel, snow cleaning and cable services;
- Authorizing tenders for maintenance and other services:
- Coaching, mentoring, motivating and recognizing direct reports, and supporting a culture within Property Management that fosters respect, teamwork and motivation to improve.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- Post-secondary diploma in Business Administration;
- Interprovincial trades certification in a relevant building trade (e.g. Plumbing, Electrical, Carpentry, Structural, etc.);
- Over seven (7) years' experience in construction, engineering, procurement and/or property management, including at least two (2) years directly managing employees;
- Experience with property development planning and program management in a multi-disciplinary construction-engineering environment;
- Two (2) years' O&M budgeting experience;
- Experience working with municipal departments and utilities;
- Experience resolving tenant/property owner issues;
- Knowledge of Northern building and living conditions;
- Knowledge of health and safety policies, practices, and regulations;
- Sound working knowledge of building, electrical, mechanical and fire systems; and



Ability to obtain WHMIS and First Aid (CPR) certification within 6 months of employment.
