LINE MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR

This leadership role would be a great opportunity for a skilled supervisor combining a strong power production and distribution background with financial management and budgeting skills.

Reporting to the Manager, Maintenance and Operations, and overseeing a team of Journeyperson Powerline Technicians, Apprentices and Trades Helpers, you will review, schedule and manage line maintenance for the 13 communities throughout the Baffin Region. Your focus will be on ensuring reliable service as you plan and direct capital projects relating to distribution systems, assign and schedule work, approve crew travel, organize air charters for emergencies, and participate with the Manager in scheduling planned outages. This position requires some travel to regional centres and other communities in small aircraft, and being on-call at all times to provide direction during emergencies.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Preparing reports on operational requirements regarding line repair and maintenance;
- Ensuring meter readings are completed on time and line maintenance targets are met:
- · Continually updating records on departmental equipment and assets;
- · Assisting in developing budgets, as well as managing actual costs vs budgets;
- · Finalizing recoverable projects and CSOs or final invoicing;
- · Liaising with members of the public regarding line maintenance crew activities;
- Ensuring line activities adhere to regulatory requirements and safety procedures and policies;
- Overseeing all line maintenance personnel in coordination with the Maintenance Supervisors (Kivalliq & Kitikmeot Regions) across the territory, from monitoring performance to identifying training needs;
- Reviewing and submitting budget proposals for line maintenance and repair, travel and staffing; and
- Coordinating planning projects of structural designs for cable placements with Engineering.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- Grade 12 high school diploma (minimum) with a Red Seal Journeyperson Powerline Technician certification, or an acceptable combination of demonstrated experience and formal education in the distribution field, planning layout and maintenance stratagems;
- Extensive experience (5+ years) in the production and distribution of power;
- Experience in preparing capital and operating budgets, and supervising employees and contractors;
- · Ability to manage time and prioritize multiple tasks effectively to meet deadlines;
- Ability to interpret and evaluate maintenance and repair work needs and costs;
- Good verbal and written communication skills to respond to customer complaints and deal with staff and contract workers;
- · Good analytical, diagnostic and problem-solving skills;
- · Skills using email, word-processing and spreadsheet programs; and
- Knowledge of job-related aerial and heavy equipment.

ASSETS:

- · Knowledge of Nunavut, the land, language and culture; and
- · Ability to speak Inuktitut, Inuinnaqtun and/or French.

We offer a competitive salary ranging from \$109,262.40 to \$139,651.20 per annum and a comprehensive benefits package, including a Northern Living Allowance of \$15,016 per annum. This position is not included in the Nunavut Employees Union. Subsidized staff housing is available.

Preference will be given to Nunavut Inuit.
