Are you the type of person that enjoys both physical and administrative work? Can you communicate well with co-workers and customers alike? If so, this multi-faceted position would be a great career opportunity.

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, you will provide labour support to maintenance crews and plant staff by assisting with a wide variety of operations and maintenance duties: installations, repairs, oil changes, fuel transfers, meter reads, disconnects, and more. You will also liaise between Operations and Customer Service staff, in order to issue notices of disconnects and carry out physical disconnections. As a Trades Helper, you will be working primarily outdoors, and will be excepted to adhere to safety procedures and generally support a culture of safety.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Performing meter readings, issuing notices, installing load limiters, and completing disconnects;
- Maintaining shops, trucks, yards and other corporate property clean and well organized;
- Assisting Customer Service in coordinating the issuance of notices of disconnects;
- · Communicating with customers with overdue accounts and disconnects;
- · Managing conflict with customers that may arise during disconnects; and
- Gaining an understanding of the Terms & Conditions of Service.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- · High school diploma or equivalent;
- · Valid Class 5 driver's licence;
- · Manual skills to complete basic repairs;
- · Ability to communicate effectively, both in writing and verbally;

- · Ability to work with minimal supervision;
- · Ability to perform basic administrative duties;
- Proficiency with computer applications, including MS Office, Adobe, and the internet:
- Physical ability to handle occasional heavy lifting, stretching and pulling, and work at heights;
- Ability to travel to regional centres and other communities via medium/small aircraft, as required.
